**10**<sup>th</sup> **July, 2022**: Announcement of the SPN Best Manuscript Award 2021 at SPN General Assembly, in Paris, the work by Mateus-Pinheiro A and Patrício P et al. Hippocampal cytogenesis abrogation impairs inter-regional communication between the hippocampus and prefrontal cortex and promotes the time-dependent manifestation of emotional and cognitive deficits from Luísa Pinto group.

The SPN Board also decided to give an honorable mention to the manuscript that was in second given their high quality and scores: Ribeiro LF et al., Ligand-independent activity of the ghrelin receptor modulates AMPA receptor trafficking and supports memory formation from Ana Luísa Carvalho group.
